- 2. Zoning Plan Check (Feb 14, 20)
 - Comments from Zoning Plan Check
 - i. Total Floor Area We have reviewed our calculations and have corrected the Project Information Chart accordingly.
 - ii. Building Setbacks We have corrected the Project Information Chart to be consistent with the Site Plan.
 - iii. 45 degree 3 meter driveway view lines on Summit Ave. have been shown on the Site Plan and Ground Floor Plan.
 - iv. 6 short term bicycle parking stalls An outdoor bike rack has been added to the Site Plan.
- 3. Building Canopies
 - The canopies have been adjusted on the drawings to not extend over a property line. No encroachment onto the City right-of-way is planned.

4. Benches

• The benches have been removed from the drawings. The client does not want to 'invite' people onto the property by providing benches.

5. Sidewalks

• The sidewalks have been drawn to include 1500 mm clearance at Hydro poles.

Street Trees

We have deleted the westerly most tree as per your recommendation.

7. Landscape Plan – Green Wall

 We have updated our Exterior Elevations and Renderings to more accurately reflect the finished product.

8. Short Term Bike Rack

 We have added a short-term bike rack to the site plan, along Nanaimo St. We note that the final location will be determined in conjunction with the Engineering Dept.

9. Powerpoint.

 We will finish revising our drawings and prepare a Power Point presentation using the template you have provided.

10. Resubmission

- We will resubmit the entire package, including a letter indicating the changes we have made since the last submission.
- 11. Letter to Council please find attached the updated Letter to Council. (April 13, 20) It has been updated to reflect the current updates included in our team's submission.

12. List of Changes.

- The following items have been revised since the February 14,20 submission:
 - o Project Information Chart has been modified to reflect the current design.
 - o Site Plan
 - Street trees reduced from 7 to 6 to better address tree spacing.
 - The canopy over the Summit Ave. vehicle entrance has been reduced in length. It is now fully within the property and not overhanging the property line.
 - The Summit St. vehicle entrance has been modified to provide the necessary sight-lines to traffic.
 - The benches on Summit Ave. have been removed.
 - A short-term bicycle rack has been placed along Nanaimo St., at the face of the building.
 - o Exterior Elevations & Renderings
 - The 'green wall' has been modified in the images (exterior colour elevations and 3D renderings to more accurately reflect the type of planting being proposed.
